a workshop on Governance in Local Government

Decision making processes can be ‘make or break’ for Councils. Done well they can provide strategic focus and reflect clear accountabilities. When these processes fail the organisation and its people are exposed to a myriad of reputational, financial and occupational health and safety risks.

This full day workshop targets staff across the Local Government sector who are not specialist governance staff, but whose roles require them to have a clear understanding of the governance context and arrangements. It will help participants to better understand and articulate appropriate decision making models for Local Government.

Program content

The content will include interactive workshops to enable learnings to be contextualised and personalised. Topics include:

- Why is good governance important?
- Ethics
- Local Government Governance Framework
- Conflict of interest
- Principles of good practice
- Delegations and authorisations
- Access to information and the organisation
- The politics – relationships and dynamics (presented by a former Local Government CEO)
- Working with Councillors (presented by a former Local Government Councillor)
- Panel discussion with Local Government governance experts – what do you want to know?

Council officers working across various disciplines within a Council including Directors, Managers, Coordinator/Team Leaders, Project Officers, people new to a Governance Officer role, Executive Assistants to CEO and Councillors/ Mayor.
