How to get there:

Location:

The City of Casey is located at Bunjil Place, 2 Patrick NE Dr, Narre Warren VIC 3085. The quickest outbound route if driving is the Monash (M1) Freeway, or Prince Hwy. The meeting will be held in the Bunjil Place Function Centre. This is located on the ground floor, to the left of the Café that you will see upon entering, and there should be a sign out the front with the event name. There are concierge staff in the foyer who can assist with directions if required.

Parking:

Parking is completely free around the Bunjil Place/Fountain Gate shopping precinct, however there are some 2- and 3-hour zones. Public Transport:

The closest train station is Narre Warren, which is approx. a 15 minute walk to Bunjil Place. There also bus services to and from the Fountain Gate shopping precinct, which is next to Bunjil Place- these also run to and from the train station.
